# **Sociology Survey**

For this project, you will be creating a survey to give to the students at McGuinness. The survey can be about anything that you want, as long as it gets approved through the teacher first. You will propose a topic, create a draft survey, give that survey to the class as a pilot, refine, and give the final survey to a total of twenty McGuinness students.

## 1. Proposal (topic)

- a. Get in a group with up to four total people
- b. Come up with a topic, write it down on a piece of paper with your group members' names, and give it to the teacher for approval

### 2. First Draft Survey

- a. At least two demographic questions
- b. At least one open-ended response question
- c. At least four closed-ended question, at least one of which must be Likert (with appropriate labels)
- d. Identify your target population (not included on final survey)
  - i. Tell me how you plan to gather your sample, and which method of random assignment that you will use

#### 3. Second Draft Survey

a. TYPED and visually clean copy of survey satisfying the above criteria

#### 4. Pilot Data

- a. Print four copies of second draft survey and give them to the class
- Freehand draw visual results from your survey (using at least one percentage number, and at least one graph)

- 5. Final Survey
  - a. After pilot modifications are made, you will give your final survey to twenty students at
    McGuinness
- 6. Results (visual representation of your survey results)
  - a. In one poster or paper, you will visually represent your findings, which must include:
    - i. At least one percentage result
    - ii. At least one bar graph result
    - iii. At least one pie graph result
    - iv. Representation of open-ended responses
